#### Situation end of 2021

- Annual budget of k€ 955 approved online end of 2020
- HER 1

  € 276,168 + € 31,148 (overheads) = total of € 307,316 spent on € 446,783 available including 2020 remaining amount.
  - Executive Secretary (France, Germany and Spain for secondments and Cirad [value: k€ 27]), offices (value k€ 10 from Occitanie Region through Agropolis International / Alliance and k€ 6 from INRA)
  - It is anticipated that the level of expenditures will let less than k€ 139 available at the end of the year
